

- > We use <u>Simple Present Tense</u> for an action which happens every day or all the time.
 - I get up early every morning.
 - My sisters **cook** very well.

3. What does he do before lunch?

- They <u>play</u> football every Sunday.
- Liz and Ann go to Spain every year.
- > Add "-s" to the verbs for the subjects "He, She, It".
 - Ahmet likes hamburger.
 - She eats salad for dinner.
- > Use "do not (don't) / does not (doesn't) for the negative form before verb.
 - I don't get up early every morning.
 - Ahmet <u>doesn't like</u> hamburger.
- > Use "DO" and "DOES" before subject for the question form.
 - <u>Do you get up</u> early every morning?
 Yes, I do. / No, I don't. (short answer)
 - Does Ahmet like hamburger?
 Yes, he does. / No, he doesn't.
- Use "DO" and "DOES" with question words, too.
 - What time do you get up?
 - What time does your father start work?
 - What do you drink for breakfast?
 - How does she go to school?

For verbs ending in -ch,
-sh, -ss and -o, -x add

"-es" in the third person

qo - qoes

singular

- finish finishes
- watch watches
- kiss kisses
- For verbs ending in a consonant + y, remove -y and add "-ies"
 - marry marries
 - study studies
 - carry carries
 - worry worries





For verbs that end in a **vowel + y,** we just add **-s**










AT

We use 'at' with time.

- I get up at 5 o'clock in the morning.
- The concert starts at 7 p.m.
- We never go out at night.

at the weekend

- at night
- at Christmas/ Easter
- at the end of ...
- **at** the moment
- at dinner
- at ten o'clock

IN

We use 'in' with months, years, parts of the day and seasons.

- We celebrate my brother's birthday in August.
- My father was born in 1960.
- My grandmother always calls us in the morning.
- Snow falls in winter.

- in the afternoon
- in the evening
- in 1950
- in summer
- in November


ON

We use 'on' with dates and days.

- We have English lesson on Tuesday.
- Ceylin's birthday is **on** March 17.

Next - Next Saturday


