

I know it's not healthy but I hate breakfast. I get dressed and then go to work by my car. I start work at half past eight. I drink a cup of coffee before lunch. I don't like tea. I have lunch with my company employees at twelve o'clock. They are very hard-working. I finish work at quarter to six. I get home at half past six. Then I have a bowl of soup and some salad for dinner. I don't eat much. I go out after dinner and meet my friends in a café at quarter past eight. We have fun with them. Then I get home at half past ten. I have a shower and brush my teeth before going to bed. I don't watch TV as I don't like it. At eleven o'clock I go to bed.

➤ We use **Simple Present Tense**

for an action which happens every day or all the time.

- I get up early every morning.
- My sisters cook very well.
- They play football every Sunday.
- Liz and Ann go to Spain every year.

➤ Add "-s" to the verbs for the subjects "He, She, It".

- Ahmet likes hamburger.
- She eats salad for dinner.

➤ Use "do not (don't) / does not (doesn't)" for the negative form before verb.

- I don't get up early every morning.
- Ahmet doesn't like hamburger.

➤ Use "DO" and "DOES" before subject for the question form.

- Do you get up early every morning?
Yes, I do. / No, I don't. (short answer)
- Does Ahmet like hamburger?
Yes, he does. / No, he doesn't.

★ Use "DO" and "DOES" with question words, too.

- What time do you get up?
- What time does your father start work?
- What do you drink for breakfast?
- How does she go to school?

❖ For verbs ending in -ch, -sh, -ss and -o, -x add "-es" in the third person singular

- go - goes
- finish - finishes
- watch - watches
- kiss - kisses

❖ For verbs ending in a consonant + y, remove -y and add "-ies"

- marry - marries
- study - studies
- carry - carries
- worry - worries

















For verbs that end in a vowel + y, we just add -s

- play - plays
- enjoy - enjoys
- say - says



PREPOSITION OF TIME

AT

We use 'at' with time.

- I get up **at** 5 o'clock in the morning.
- The concert starts **at** 7 p.m.
- We never go out **at** night.

- **at** the weekend
- **at** night
- **at** Christmas/ Easter
- **at** the end of ...
- **at** the moment
- **at** dinner
- **at** ten o'clock

IN

We use 'in' with months, years, parts of the day and seasons.

- We celebrate my brother's birthday **in** August.
- My father was born **in** 1960.
- My grandmother always calls us **in** the morning.
- Snow falls **in** winter.

- **in** the morning
- **in** the afternoon
- **in** the evening
- **in** 1950
- **in** summer
- **in** November

ON

We use 'on' with dates and days.

- We have English lesson **on** Tuesday.
- Ceylin's birthday is **on** March 17.

- **on** Monday morning
- **on** Wednesday afternoon
- **on** Christmas day
- **on** the 15th of January

We don't use at/in/on before:

This - This morning

Last - Last weekend

Next - Next Saturday

Every - Every day
