- Snow falls in winter.

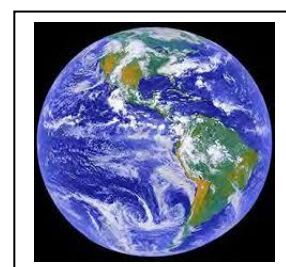
c. to show an action planned for the future (travel plans, timetables, programmes, schedules):
